
## **Illustrated Story**

12-page Book with Cover

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Roll the Story Dice ONCE.
- 2. In the rectangle at right, circle the three pictures that come up on the dice.
- 3. Using the 3 things you circled, write a very simple story or poem, maximum 300 words.
- 4. Decide how to separate and spread the story over 12 pages and brainstorm what kind of illustrations or photos would best suit your story. The page diagrams on the next page can help you plan as well as the mock-up that you will make.
- 5. Now it is time to make a mock-up so that you can see the interesting format of this book and how it will affect your creative decisions.

Get 3 sheets of A4 paper and trim them down so that they are 22cm wide by 14.5cm high. If you are in the USA, use three sheets of letter-size paper and trim to 8  $\frac{5}{8}$  "x 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ ".



By turning some of the pages upside down and interleaving them, the resulting 12-page book makes for an unusual experience for the page turner.







You will imagine a completely different story depending on the roll of the dice!



#### **REQUIREMENTS**

A well-written, up-beat story no more than 300 words. Draft and final corrected copy.

#### At least 6 illustrations.

I encourage you to have at least one illustration that spans two pages: probably pages 6 & 7.

It is always a good idea to have several small illustrations to augment the main visuals.

#### The Book can be done either by hand or on the computer. There are separate rubrics for each.

There are many things that you must take into consideration when designing your book:

- How to divide the story so that there is an equal amount of text on most pages.
- Typefaces: Style and size
- Consistent style of photography and/or artwork that brings your story to life
- Color, Texture
- Flow of words and visuals throughout book

## **Notes for Digital Book**

Use the Screen Template for a square book, 145mm x 145mm

This project is designed for intermediate level InDesign skills so digital publishing (epub) is not included in the line-up, but can certainly be done if you have the skills!

The book can be exported as:

- an interactive .pdf file or
- a .swf file with interactive page-curl

#### What to Turn-in

- **1. finished file** for viewing (.pdf or .swf)
- 2. packaged project (File>Package) which includes fonts and all image files
- 3. sketches and paper mock-up of book.
- 4. written reflection 150-300 words:

**Guiding Questions** 

- What parts of your story do you feel still need work?
- What questions would you like your peers to help you with?
- How did you come up with your story? Where did you find inspiration?
- Was it easy to come up with different illustrations?
- What technical difficulties did you encounter? What did you learn?


### **Illustrations & Layout**


- Do **NOT** download and use illustrations that you find on the Internet —that is **plagiarism**.
- You may use downloaded illustrations as a guide to *create your own images in Illustrator or Photoshop*.
- ALL illustrations and/or photography used in your publication MUST be turned-in with your InDesign file. I will check your illustrations for to see that you created them yourself.
- Remember very creative things can be done with type. Type can be a form of illustration.
- Keep the style of your illustrations and type **consistent**.
- MAKE SKETCHES BEFORE YOU GET ON THE COMPUTER.
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- MAKE SKETCHES BEFORE YOU GET ON THE COMPUTER.
- Use color, texture, transparency, hierarchy and do not settle on your first idea.


Page Layout
Use InDesign Template if you do your final version in InDesign


















BACK SIDE OF PAPER FRONT SIDE OF PAPER
